Horse Trials Qualifier & Team Training

The area Horse Trials qualifier for 2008 is 13th July and will be at Larkhill, Salisbury. Teams will be selected from the training sessions by the instructors.

Members who want to be selected for the horse trials team must come to dressage, show jumping and cross country training. There is already dressage team training and show jumping team training running - you should attend preferably at least 2 sessions of each. If you are not already involved in these teams and the current training the information is on the website. Please state on your training forms that you are interested in the horse trials team when doing dressage or show jump training.

The cross country schooling for the team will be incorporated with the training on 10th May and 21st June (see the website for details and apply for a place as normal) Further training for the team can be arranged prior to the competition where all 3 phases can be practiced.

The classes are split as below:

Novice	Max Height 0.85 cm	BRC HN 1 (2001)
Intermediate	Max Height 1.00m	BRC H1 2 (2006)
Open	Max Height 1.10m	BRC HO 3 (2005)

Eligibility

Novice Team

Horses may be registered with BE but may not have any points, nor may they have been placed in the first six places on any BE Pre Novice competition.

Intermediate Team

Horses may be registered with BE but must not have any points

Open Team

BE points allowed 0- 20. However horses with up to 60 BE points may be entered but they will incur 1 penalty point for every BE point over the maximum of 20.
